

"A Lifetime Assignment"

everend Doctor Howard E. McNair was born April 6,1946 in Wayne County North Carolina. He is the only son of the late Willie McNair and Marie McNair Parker.

He transitioned from labor to reward on Tuesday, June 15, 2021 at the Kitty Askins Hospice Center in Goldsboro, North Carolina, while surrounded by his loving family. He attended Goldsboro City Schools and graduated in the class of 1965 from Dillard High School.

Pastor McNair attended Moody Bible Institute, Chicago, Illinois; Shaw University, Raleigh, North Carolina; Trinity Bible College, Grand Rapids, Michigan; and Hampton Ministers' Institute, Hampton, Virginia. He also completed courses as a continuing education student at Trinity Bible College, Grand Rapids, Michigan. In July of 1995, Elder McNair was bestowed an Honorary Doctor of Divinity Degree from the United Christian College of the United Holy Church of America. He was



an avid reader and maintained an extensive library of Biblical literature. He was rarely seen without a book in his hand.

Pastor McNair was reared in the Baptist Denomination until the age of 14 when he accepted the call to the ministry and joined Guiding Star United Holy Church, Goldsboro, North Carolina in 1957 under the late Bishop J. D. Brown. He embarked on an evangelistic campaign in which he led a myriad of men and women to Jesus Christ.

He began serving as an Associate Minister at New Stoney Hill United Holy Church, Goldsboro, NC under the late Rev. B. B. Dunn in 1964. He also served as Pastor for Mount Olive Holy Church, Bennettsville, South Carolina; Holy Temple United Holy Church, Henderson, North Carolina; Calvary Temple Holy Church, Henderson, North Carolina; Morton Temple Holy Church, Greensboro, North Carolina; and Faith Tabernacle Holy Church, Stantonsburg, North Carolina.

Elder McNair loved the United Holy Church and served in various capacities throughout his life not limited to but including Eastern District field worker, 2nd Vice president of the Eastern District YPHA under the late Eddie Britt. While under the United Holy Church International, he and Elder H.B. McDonald of the Western District reorganized the Union. Elder McNair was the General Superintendent of the United Holy Church International.

He was an instructor for the United Christian College, Goldsboro, North Carolina for many years. He will always be fondly remembered for teaching Biblical Preaching, Church Doctrine, and Scriptural Interpretation. Elder McNair loved good preaching and with a purpose tutored and mentored numerous ministers and pastors.

For over 56 years Dr. McNair served as Pastor of New Stoney Hill United Holy Church, Goldsboro, North Carolina. During his extensive career he labored in the vineyard as a District Elder of the Southern District Convocation, Co-Chairperson of the General Board of Elders of the United Holy Church of America as well as past Co-chair of the Board of Elders of the Southern District Convocation. For over 40 years he served as President of the Eastern District Union and was recently honored by the Eastern District officers and members for his dedicated service. He continued his pastoral assignment even during his final days in hospice care. Pastor McNair prayed for and anointed one of his members and preached a short sermon.

The fruits of his lifelong assignment will continue to blossom for many days to come.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by two sisters; Betty McNair and Wilma McNair.

Pastor McNair leaves a legacy of love and precious memories for his tireless caregiver, his lovely and supportive wife, First Lady Veda Horton McNair; two wonderful children, Mrs. Tamika M.
